**P** <sup>1</sup>The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear?

**C** **The LORD is the stronghold of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?**

**P** <sup>2</sup>When evildoers assail me to eat up my flesh,

**C** **My adversaries and foes, it is they who stumble and fall.**

**P** <sup>3</sup>Though an army encamp against me, my heart shall not fear;

**C** **Though war arise against me, yet I will be confident.**

**P** <sup>4</sup>One thing have I asked of the LORD, that will I seek after:

**C** **That I may dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life,**

**P** To gaze upon the beauty of the LORD and to inquire in his temple.

**C** <sup>5</sup>**For he will hide me in his shelter in the day of trouble;**

**P** He will conceal me under the cover of his tent;

**C** **He will lift me high upon a rock.**

**P** <sup>6</sup>And now my head shall be lifted up above my enemies all around me,

**C** **And I will offer in his tent sacrifices with shouts of joy;**

**P** I will sing and make melody to the LORD.

**C** <sup>7</sup>Hear, O LORD, when I cry aloud; be gracious to me and answer me!

**P** <sup>8</sup>You have said, "Seek my face."

**C** **My heart says to you, "Your face, LORD, do I seek."**

**P** <sup>9</sup>Hide not your face from me.

**C** **Turn not your servant away in anger,**

**P** O you who have been my help.

**C** **Cast me not off; forsake me not, O God of my salvation!**

**P** <sup>10</sup>For my father and my mother have forsaken me,

**C** **But the LORD will take me in.**

**P** <sup>11</sup>Teach me your way, O LORD,

**C** **And lead me on a level path because of my enemies.**

**P** <sup>12</sup>Give me not up to the will of my adversaries;

**C** **For false witnesses have risen against me,  
and they breathe out violence.**

**P** <sup>13</sup>I believe that I shall look upon the goodness of the LORD

**C** **In the land of the living!**

**P** <sup>14</sup>Wait for the LORD; be strong, and let your heart take courage;

**C** **Wait for the LORD!**
